

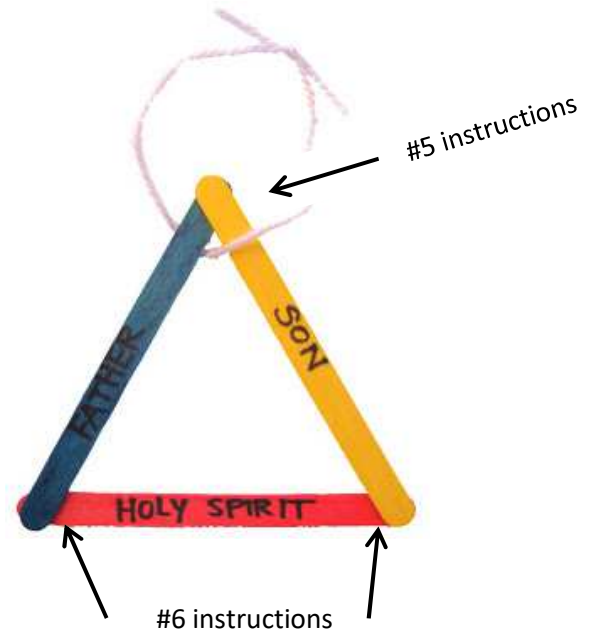
## Trinity Triangle Craft

### Craft Supplies

White Elmer's Glue, glue dots  
 Popsicle sticks  
 Yarn, string  
 Permanent Marker  
 Crayons, markers

### Instructions

1. Color each of the sticks a different color.
2. Write Father on one of the sticks.
3. Write Son on one of the sticks.
4. Write Holy Spirit on one of the sticks.
5. With Father facing up, glue the end of the stick. With Son facing up, stick this to at an angle.
6. With Holy Spirit facing up, glue both ends of the stick. Stick these ends together with Father and Son sticks.
7. Add string.



Start out by counting the three sides and then the three corners of the triangle. Cover up a side or a corner of the triangle with your hand and ask, "If I take away this part of the triangle, do I have a whole triangle?" Your answer should be, "No! There's a part missing."

God is like a triangle. He has three parts. The heart explains that He is God the Father who loves us and takes care of us. The cross explains that He is God the Son, Jesus, who died on the cross for us. Finally, the hand explains that He is God the Holy Spirit who is our helper.

"If I take away the Holy Spirit do I have all of God?" "No! You need all three parts to have all of God."

Repeat the same question about God the Father, and God the Son.
