PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS THERE ARE MANY CHANGES!

<u>Weekly Mass</u> - Commitment is made to attend Mass on Sunday in St. Mary Church for ALL of our RE classes (this includes Tuesday, Monday Monthly, AND Home Study students) at either of our two teaching Masses - 8:00am or 9:30am. Teaching Masses focus on the young learning Mass prayers and understanding the readings. **Students not registered on Sunday will receive envelopes to offer up weekly prayer intentions at their scheduled mass time.**

<u>Weekly Classes</u> - 1st-8th Grade. <u>Sunday morning</u> classes begin with Mass in St. Mary Church followed by class in St. Mary School. <u>Tuesday night classes</u> are held in St. Mary School with commitment to weekly Mass as noted above. **BOTH Sunday and Tuesday students in 8th Grade will be participating in the mass by reading the Pray of the Faithful and 2nd Graders will be bring forward the gifts. A schedule will be drawn up at the beginning of the RE year.**

<u>Monday Monthly Classes</u> - 3rd-6th Grade <u>AND one consistent parent</u>. Monthly classes are a child <u>AND</u> parent course held in St. Mary School. Classes are on the first Monday of the month, with any necessary changes. While the child is in their class, one parent per family will be given support for lessons on the off week of classes. Homework is given in class for the month and commitment to weekly Mass as noted above. **NOTE: The parent will be making the commitment to attend every month for support on teaching their child on the off weeks of class.**

<u>Home Study</u> - 3rd-6th Grade. Home Study is for active Catholics where health or travel make it too difficult to attend in person class. Students will be expected to turn in work, take unit assessments, participate in the Liturgical parish activities, and commitment to weekly Mass as noted above. **Home Study by approval only after speaking with Mrs. Zola and a maximum of 2 years.**

Tuition Payment Options:

- Online Giving, on the parish website www.mmotcp.org, open ONLINE GIVING, and Online Giving Login. Once registered, choose RE Tuition Payments Give Now and choose One Time, BE SURE TO RECORD EACH CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME IN THE SPECIAL INTENTION BOX and note the date paid on the registration form. 2nd Grade Sacramental Preparation Fee can be added to tuition, but please note Tuition & 2nd.
